Directions: Marlborough High School, 431 Bolton Street, Marlborough, MA 01752

From Route 495: Take exit 25A (Hudson - Route 85). At 2nd light, turn right onto Route 85. Continue for about 1 mile. Proceed through the traffic light at the Navin Skating Rink. Turn left at the sign for Marlborough High School (the building is not visible from the road), follow road to parking lot.

From Route 9: Take Route 30 to 85 North. Continue on Route 85 through downtown Marlborough (John Brown Bell Tower and Park will be on your right). Go through 2 traffic lights. You will pass Marlborough Middle School and the police station on your right. Immediately after an elderly housing project, turn right at the sign for Marlborough High School (the building is not visible from the road), follow road to parking lot.

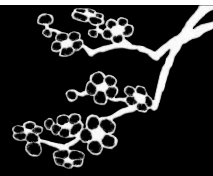
PARKING: As you near the school, the road curves to the left. Parking lots are on the side and rear of the building.
