**Letter from *Insula Sperantelor* Student to His WHFC Sponsor,
translated from Romanian**

My name is Vladimir. When I was one year and a half my parents divorced. My mother had a boy from her first marriage, but I do not remember him. She left and took him with her, but left me with her parents. My mother never came back for me, leaving me without attention or care. She lost her parental rights, and my grandfather was named my guardian.

My grandfather and grandmother raised me, and have been taking care of me until now. They are old, and live only on their pension, which is very small. They raised me with love. I think it is my duty to get an education, so I can help them and become a good man.

Last year I entered the *Insula Sperantelor* program. I wish to specialize in the foodservice industry, and chose the "Pastry cook-waiter" training. I am very happy with this choice so far.
